

From Milan (405 km): take the Autostrade del Sole A1 towards Rome, exit at "Firenze Certosa", take the Superstrada Firenze-Siena towards Siena, exit at "Siena Sud" (Porta Tufi) and take the SS2 (Cassia) towards Rome. Go past Monterone D'arbia and, after Buonconvento, turn right on the "SP45 del Brunello" to Montalcino

From Rome (219 km): follow the entire distance of the SS2 (Cassia) in the direction of Siena, following directions for Montalcino after San Quirico d'Orcia, near Torrenieri. Alternately, it is possible to take the Autostrada del Sole A1 towards Florence, exit at "Chiusi", then take SS146, pass through Chianciano Terme, Montepulciano, Pienza, San Quirico d'Orcia, and then get onto the SS2 (Cassia) in the direction of Siena and exit at Montalcino.

From Grosseto (55 km): take the Superstrada Grosseto-Siena SS223, turn right at Paganico SP64, and continue following directions for Monte Amiata until you reach the left turn for Sant'Angelo SP52. Continue on to Montalcino.

By train: The train station closest to Montalcino is in Buonconvento (see <http://www.trenitalia.it>). From the station there are buses (see <http://www.trainspa.it>) which run to Montalcino (10 km). Montalcino can also be reached by bus from Siena (38 km); see <http://www.trainspa.it>.

By air: The airports closest to Montalcino are in Florence (110 km) (<http://www.safnet.it>), Siena (38 km) (<http://www.aeroportosiena.it>), Grosseto (55 km) (<http://www.grossetoairport.com>), and Pisa (202 km) (<http://www.pisa-airport.com>).

Once in Montalcino, follow directions for Grosseto and after 2 km turn right in the direction of Castiglion del Bosco, Camigliano, Tavernelle. After 1 km there is an intersection, go straight (towards Castiglion del Bosco) onto a dirt road. After 1 km you will find Sanlorenzo on your left.
